left behind

Alike: To be similar to or identical to something.

The girls were twins and looked <u>alike</u>.

Prompt:

Name parts of your body that are alike. Which letters in the alphabet look alike? (b,d).

Do any students in the class have clothes that are alike?

Over: To be above something.

She put the umbrella <u>over</u> her head to keep the rain off.

Prompt:

Name something that is over your head. Have the students jump over something on the floor.

Behind: To be in back of something.

The dog was <u>behind</u> me.

Prompt:

Who is behind you? Who are you behind?

Left: We have two sides to our body, the right side and the left side. This is the left side.

He stood on the <u>left</u> side of the teacher.

Prompt:

Show me the left side of the book/page. Who is sitting on your left?
