Prompt:

Who is behind you?
Who are you behind?

Over: To be above something.

She put the umbrella over her head to keep the rain off.

Prompt:

Name something that is over your head.
Have the students jump over something on the floor.

Left: We have two sides to our body, the right side and the left side. This is the left side.

He stood on the left side of the teacher.

Prompt:

Show me the left side of the book/page.
Who is sitting on your left?
