### Next: Next means closest to or near to something.

The person sitting <u>next</u> to you is my friend.

Prompt:

What is next on our schedule? Who is sitting next to you?

### Front: To be ahead of something or the first part of something.

We were at the <u>front</u> of the line to go into the movie.

The <u>front</u> of the book has a picture and the title.

#### Prompt:

Show me the front of the book, the front of the room, the front of your head. When is it a good time to be at the front of the line? Why?

## Bottom: Bottom is the lowest or deepest part of something.

We found the toy in the <u>bottom</u> of the toy box.

Prompt:

Show me the bottom of the book, the bottom of your shoe, the bottom of the page, the bottom of letter z. What could you find at the bottom of the ocean?

### Away: To move from one place or go in a different direction.

We moved <u>away</u> from the bee very quickly.

#### Prompt:

Have a student walk away from the group.

Tell me something that should always keep away from your eyes, ears, mouth, nose, etc.
